## EYE AND THE NEEDLE

The giant radar vessel developed by Boeing for the U.S. Missile Defense Agency is a dramatic sight against the nighttime Seattle skyline and its famous Space Needle tower as the converted oil platform navigated last month to a local
shipyard for maintenance. The Sea-based X-band Radar, or SBX, towers more than 280 feet ( 85 meters), from its keel to the top of the huge white radome. Designed to identify, track and assess the flight characteristics of ballistic missile threats, the sensor is a key component of the Ground-based

Midcourse Defense system for which Boeing is prime contractor. Boeing won a $\$ 27.1$ million contract to perform SBX maintenance and upgrades. photo: dave hutseluboeing
